ON MISSION midweek study 2

Last week we looked at upgrading our wardrobe, and what does and doesn't look good on a believer.

Read: Titus 2:9-10

This passage says that the goal is to make the teaching of Christ attractive. People need to know what the attractiveness is connected to. Not our brilliant personality or great upbringing or even great heart – it's CHRIST IN US that is the hope of glory. We want them to ask: Where did you get that.

Read: Acts 26:1-29

Identify in Paul's story the BEFORE CHRIST section, the ENCOUNTERED CHRIST section, and the AFTER CHRIST section.

If you were to do that in your story, what would your testimony be.

Take some time in your group to write down your story.

Practise on each other, and see which bits don't really make sense or are "Christianese" – a Christian could understand them, but a non-believer couldn't.

Don't be precious in this. The goal is to get better and to get bolder so that more people might know Jesus.
